

WHAT IS DIGITAL ACCESSIBILITY?



LAWS



Section 508

Rehabilitation Act 1973 is a Federal law that requires all electronic and information technology be accessible to people with disabilities

CA Government Code Section 7405

Requires that all state agencies comply with Section 508 of the Federal Rehabilitation act

AB 434

Assembly Bill 434 (Government Code 11546.7) requires the Director and Chief Information Officer of each state agency to certify that the entity's Internet Web site is in compliance with WCAG 2.0 or subsequent version

WCAG

Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) is a set of formal guidelines on how to make web/online content more accessible for users with disabilities and on different devices (such as mobile)

BEST PRACTICES



Fonts should change size independently from the screen size



language appropriate for your audience

Caption

Videos should be captioned or provided with a transcript or sign language translation

Forms

Forms should be designed so they can be tabbed though without a mouse

Use colors with enough contrast between the foreground and background

Color Contrast



Audio and video should feature a pause option

ALT Text

Use alternative text or

<alt> tags on images

HTML

Use semantic HTML

Color

Use something other than color alone to convey information



Keep navigation simple
